### **Protecting Our Corner of the Watershed**

#### **Sanitary -vs- Storm Sewer**

It's important to understand the difference between sanitary sewers and storm sewers so we can prevent environmental damage.

**Sanitary sewer:** a system of underground pipes that carry sewage from plumbing components to a wastewater treatment plant where it is treated and discharged.

**Storm sewer:** a system of underground pipes or open ditches designed to carry rainfall runoff and other surface water drainage, not sewage or hazardous waste, untreated, into local streams, rivers and other water bodies.
