RE: SNOW AND ICE ON SIDEWALKS

This letter serves as a reminder that homeowners and business owners are responsible for removing snow and ice from their sidewalks during the winter months. Your neighborhood may have a volunteer that clears the walkways with some regularity however, it is the owner's responsibility to maintain the walks in a safe condition at all times. We understand that this is not always easy and owners/residents provide a valuable public service in this regard. The community effort involved in keeping our sidewalks safe for school children and walkers makes our village a great place to live and your help is certainly appreciated.

Winter reminders:

☐ Ordinance 660.06 states that it is the responsibility of the homeowner to clear sidewalks within 24 hours after snow has fallen. The ordinance provides for removal by the Village if necessary. All expenses incurred under these circumstances, in addition to penalties, will be charged to the homeowner and can be assessed with property taxes.

☐ Residents that travel during the winter months must make arrangements to have their sidewalks cleaned during their absence.

☐ State law prohibits placing snow in the street.

A hearty thanks is due those special individuals that go beyond their own properties to assist the rest of us with snow removal. Thank you one and all!
