Road Improvements Coming to: West Jefferson Street

Plans are in motion to mill and resurface W. Jefferson Street from Bridge Street west to the Village limits. The exact construction schedule is not known at this time. The entire project should take less than a month once started, depending on the weather. The work involves pulverizing and shaping the existing asphalt pavement, grading and compacting the subgrade, repaving with four inches of asphalt and upgrading sidewalk ramps to current ADA specifications. Information will be shared as it becomes available. Residents are encouraged to check www.villageofdimondale.org regularly for updates and to "like" us on Face Book. Residents in the project area will receive direct communication from the Village Office once the details are known.

Protecting Our Corner of the Watershed

Do You Know Your Watershed?

A watershed is defined as an area that drains to a common point. That common point may be a lake, the outlet of a river or any point within a river system. In the urban watershed, storm drains or catch basins are designed to carry stormwater away from developed (highly impervious) areas to prevent flooding. Anything that enters the storm drain or catch basins eventually ends up in our local rivers. This type of pollution is the number one water quality problem in the nation.



Things we should do:

-  Clean up your pet's waste.
-  Use low or no-phosphorus fertilizers.
-  Wash your car on the lawn instead of pavement.
-  Maintain all vehicles, eliminating leaks and spills.
-  Use native vegetation and reduce turf grass by increasing native wildflowers and grasses.

Brush Collection Monday, April 30th – Brush and branches: must be at the curb by 9am the day of collection, cannot exceed 9-10 inches in diameter, must be placed in manageable piles facing the same direction, and should not be mixed with other materials.
