## **COVID-19 SCREENING PROGRAM**

Under the Governor's Executive Order 2020-60, food-selling establishments must implement temporary safety measures to safeguard employees, volunteers, and customers from the COVID-19 respiratory disease. This guidance includes developing and implementing a daily screening procedure with all staff and volunteers upon arriving at, or just prior to arriving at, the market. The Dimondale Farmers' Market Screening Program includes the following questions and protocols:

### **A. Do you have any of the following symptoms?**

- i. Fever of 100.4 degrees or higher as measured by a touchless thermometer (if a touchless thermometer is not available, employees will be encouraged to measure their own temperature and provide verbal confirmation of lack of fever)
- ii. Cough (excluding chronic cough due to a known medical reason other than COVID-19)
- iii. Shortness of breath
- iv. Sore throat
- v. Diarrhea (excluding diarrhea due to a known medical reason other than COVID-19)

### **B. Have you travelled internationally or outside of Michigan in the last 14 days, excluding commuting from a home location outside of Michigan?**

### **C. Have you had any close contact in the last 14 days with someone with a diagnosis of COVID-19?**

If an employee or volunteer responds yes to A, that person will be excluded from work and may not return until: at least 72 hours have passed with no fever, seven days have passed since symptoms began, and no other symptoms have appeared.

If an employee or volunteer responds yes to B or C, they will be excluded from work for 14 days following their return or exposure.

If an employee or volunteer tests positive for COVID-19, the market manager will notify food vendors and other employees of the positive test result as soon as possible and in no case later than 12 hours after receiving the test result, without revealing the personal health-related information of any person.
