CUES FROM CAPTAIN CURBYSM

- Place trash street-side by 7 a.m. on Fridays
- Bag all trash before placing it in the cart.
- Double bag loose materials like kitty litter, animal waste, sawdust, ashes.
 insulation and packing peanuts.
- Place long items like broom handles, curtain rods, etc. on the ground beside the trash.

RECYCLING, YARD WASTE AND BULK COLLECTION

Street-side recycling, yard waste and bulk item (such as appliances or furniture) collection is available from Granger for an additional charge. Contact Granger to sign up or to get more information.

CARTS

All residents will receive a 96-gallon cart for their trash. If you don't want to keep your cart, you may put your trash out in bags, but we will not be able to service your trash in store-bought containers. Using Granger-provided containers ensures that they are maintained and replaced when necessary. If you don't want to keep your cart, please contact Granger at 517-372-2800 or info@grangernet.com. (Be sure to include your name and service address if emailing us.)

Your cart will hold approximately five bags of trash, which



is the Village's current contract limit per residence. You may also place an occasional extra bag outside the cart.

OBSERVED HOLIDAYS

All Granger offices and operations are closed for the following holidays:

- · New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- · Independence Day
- · Labor Day
- · Thanksgiving Day
- · Christmas Day

If the holiday falls on a weekday, your trash and recycling collection will be delayed until Saturday. If the holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay.

PLACEMENT OF CART

Your trash will be collected by a truck that uses an automated arm to empty the cart. How you place the cart is very important. Please consult the enclosed flyer for instructions.

WELCOME TO GRANGER! WASTE ACCEPTANCE GUIDELINES

Granger is pleased to be your new waste hauler. In order to ensure we are complying with all state rules and regulations and so our associates can do their jobs safely, please carefully follow our waste acceptance guidelines. They also protect you!

PLEASE **DO NOT** PUT ANY OF THE FOLLOWING IN YOUR TRASH:

- Open, empty or used beverage containers (with a deposit)
- Whole car or truck tires (scrap tires)
- · Grass clippings or leaves
- Used oil (Oil filters must be drained for 24 hours before being placed in trash.)
- · Car or truck batteries
- Oil-based paint (Latex paint is allowed, but only if dried.)
- Refrigerants/Freon (must be properly removed from appliances prior to disposal)
- Empty drums (unless clean and crushed)
- · Explosives, ammunition or firearms
- Propane or other compressed gas tanks (unless empty and disabled)

AUTOMATED COLLECTION SYSTEM

HOW TO PLACE YOUR CURBY

Please help us ensure our new automated collection system works smoothly and efficiently by following these guidelines for placement of your cart.

CART PLACEMENT GUIDELINES

- Cart should be in place by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
- Cart should face forward.
- · Cart should be placed within 3 feet of the street.
- Cart should have a minimum of 2 feet of clearance on both sides. Please do not place any closer than 2 feet to poles, mailboxes or other containers.
- Cart should be unobstructed (no vehicles parked in front of the cart).

CORRECT PLACEMENT OF CURBY





Cart is facing forward, within 3 feet of the street edge, unobstructed with a minimum of 2 feet clearance.

INCORRECT PLACEMENT OF CURBY



Cart is too close to pole.



Cart is not facing forward. (Number stamp and metal bar should be facing the street.)



Cart is obstructed by car.
