### **Old Business**

1. Ammarman presented the removal of 7378 Creyts Rd. (parcel 080-002-300-080-00) from Sewer District #8 as the hookup is no longer needed due to homeowner's installation of a new septic system. Motion by Reznick, second Roesner, to recommend an amendment to the Utilities Agreement as presented. Motion carried unanimously, Slucter absent.

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#### **New Business**

- 1. Gallagher provided an overview of the 2020-21 draft budget.
- 2. Gallagher presented the 2020-21 Rate Study for member review noting that several projects have been added to the Capital Improvement Plan and this will continue to be the case in coming years as more items are identified for future replacement. Gallagher also noted that staff will receive updated rate study software and training from Michigan Rural Water to help improve the process. Discussion followed regarding a possible future rate increase and amending the rate study to fund Capital Improvements at 50% to maintain the \$35.00/month rate proposed in the draft budget.
