IMPORTANT NOTICE

Pine St., Reedy Ct., and Van Buren St. Residents

Please be informed that the Village will be resurfacing Pine Street, Reedy Court and Van Buren Street in the near future. You have probably noticed the curb markings which indicate areas of repair and you will shortly see the contractor begin mobilizing for the project. This flyer will provide you with some idea of what to expect during the construction:

- The project consists of pulverizing the existing road, curb and gutter repairs, removing excess material from the road bed, and paving (two courses).
- Work is scheduled to begin the week of July 12th with completion by the week of August 16th. This schedule is completely weather dependent and may change as a result.
- Construction hours will run from approximately 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday through Friday.
- At this time, we do not anticipate weekend work, however this could change if unforeseen circumstances affect the schedule.
- **Pulverizing is scheduled for the week of July 30th** – if conditions are favorable. This is a loud and dusty process and will be completed in one day.
- **You will be able to access your property at all times** except when equipment is actively working in the area (pulverizing, pouring concrete, paving).
- Parking in the road at night will be allowed but all cars must be off the streets during the day (by 7:00 am).
- Trash collection will occur early and we ask you to **have your trash bin at the curb by 6:00 am** through the duration of the project.
- **Brush collection will take place on Monday July 26th** as planned. Brush and branches must be at the curb by 9:00 am.
- It is possible your mail will be delayed if conditions prevent delivery on certain days. Please contact the Post Office if you have questions or problems in this regard at 646.6662.

We will communicate significant information during the construction through flyers like this one and do our best to keep you informed. Road work is dusty and dirty and then it's done. Your patience is greatly appreciated as we proceed with this public improvement.
